### Prof. Dr. Changyong Sun



**Changyong Sun** is Professor of Law at the Southwest University of Political Science and Law, and Vice Chairman of the China Association of Criminal Procedure Law. He served as a Vice Chancellor of SWUPL from August 2009 to March 2017. His research interests focus on criminal procedure, criminal evidence, especially from the comparative perspective. He has publicized four books including *Pre-trial Investigations and Human Rights: A Comparative Study*, *The Right to Remain in Silence*, *Exploring Due Process of Law: Comparative Criminal Procedure*. His articles have appeared on prominent journals such as *Chinese Journal of Law*, *China Legal Science* and *Zeitschrift für Internationale Strafrechtsdogmatik* (Germany). Currently, he is leading a key research project granted by the National Office for Philosophy and Social Sciences on the implementation of consensual criminal procedure in China. From September 1995 to August 1996, he was a senior visiting scholar to Columbia University School of Law (USA). Since 1998, he has made scholastic visits to countries such as Belgium, USA, UK, France, Germany, Russia, Denmark, Sweden, Canada, Italy, Switzerland, The State of Qatar and Japan.
