Dr. Dan Wei



Dan Wei is a senior researcher in the Procuratorial Theory Institute of Supreme People's Procuratorate of P.R.China. He has been focusing on the criminal procedure and the criminal law reform in China for nearly 20 years. The contributions he made are the research reports submitted to the Supreme People's Procuratorate and the National People's Congress which promoted substantial progresses in the process of the judicial reform. The representative ones are transformed as the Article 183 in the amendment of Criminal law in 1996 and the Article 93 in the Criminal Procedure Law of 2012. The Article 93 is about the judicial review of the necessity of pre-trial detention by prosecutor. The goal is to reduce the number of pre-trial detention and expand the practical use for bail. More than half a million detainees have been released by its implementation since 2012. He got his Juris doctor degree in Wuhan University in 1996 and received the award of special subsidies from the State Council of P.R.China in 2005.
