Darryl K. Brown is the O.M. Vicars Professor of Law and Barron F. Black Research Professor at the University of Virginia School of Law. He teaches Criminal Law, Criminal Adjudication, Transnational Criminal Law, and Evidence. He was previously the Class of 1958 Alumni Professor of Law at Washington and Lee University School of Law.

He is the author of "Free Market Criminal Justice: How Democracy and Laissez Faire Undermine the Rule of Law." Before entering academia, Professor Brown clerked for the Chief Judge the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit and for three years practiced criminal law and corporate litigation.
